We just need to inform you of a couple of things that will be happening in the upcoming weeks. As of next week we will be sending home the children's learning journey's for you to share with your children, this is a time for you to see what the children do whilst at pre-school and how they are progressing in their learning. This is a chance for you both to reflect on their experiences and think about the next steps on their learning journey. We will then use this information to plan our activities around the children in order to enhance their future learning. We would ask that you have the folders over the weekend and return them the following week with the 'Look what I can do' sheet.

Our intention is to hold a Parent's Information Evening on Wednesday 2nd of April at 6:30pm. During the evening we will give a short presentation on the three prime areas of learning within the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum these being Communication and Language where we will include phonics, Physical Development and Personal, Social and Emotional Development. This will provide you with an insight into how we provide learning experiences for the children. After the presentation the staff will be available for you to ask any questions about their learning journeys or any queries you may have.




We planted some beans, come and see how they are growing.
